### SCHOOL BUSES AND PARKING

Buses will need to drop students off at the **Bernie Smith Gate** on **Moorabool Street** where they will be met by BioCATS Staff. Please note this is a pick up and drop off zone only.

Please look for directional signage. Coaches are to return at a designated time to pick up students. Maps will be supplied with confirmation of booking.

### ON ARRIVAL

Visitors are required to report to the Deakin Cats Community Centre Reception Desk and register their attendance.

### HOSPITALITY

Supervision of students during the lunch break is the responsibility of the home school teacher(s). The consumption of food and/or drink is only permitted in designated areas. Students attending must bring their own lunches, snacks and drinks. **There are no canteen facilities available.**
